

## Daystar University College

### Brief History

Daystar originated in Bulawayo, Zimbabwe in 1963, founded jointly by South African refugee, S.E.M. Pheko, and Dr. Donald K. Smith. During the next four years, a Christian publishing ministry was established under the name of Daystar Publications. Increasing requests for help in training of national workers in finding solutions to major problems in communications led to Daystar Communications in 1967.

Daystar Communications was incorporated in the U.S.A. in 1967. By 1969, Daystar was exclusively concerned with training, research and consultation. At the beginning of 1974, headquarters were moved to Nairobi, Kenya.

### Academic Policy

Daystar University College is a Christian Liberal Arts College with the aim of training the leadership of the continent of Africa. Daystar offers accredited Bachelors of Arts (B.A.) and Master of Arts (M.A.) degrees in conjunction with Messiah College and Wheaton College respectively. In addition, Daystar provides short term training courses for African leaders and supports the African church through research.

### Daystar's Working Philosophy

Daystar sees man and nature as the handiwork of God and considers that all truth comes from God. Remembering that in Christ are all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge, Daystar approaches its total educational task from a Christian point of view. It attempts to carry out a comprehensive educational programme to prepare students to reach their maximum fulfilment in serving God, church, fellowman and country in the changing educational and social situation of today.

### Programmes

Daystar offers programmes of study leading to Bachelor of Arts Degree in Bible, Communication, Business Administration and Management. With minors in Bible, Business Administration and Management, Christian Ministries, Communications and Community Development.

Master of Arts Degree in Communications and Christian Ministries, Certificate studies in: Business Administration and Management, Christian Communication, Christian Ministries, Community Development and Music.
